

## The Dr Graham's Homes OGBs - Heal the World Project

### *Note from the Project Director*

This cover version of Michael Jackson's 'Heal the World' dedicated to our school Dr Graham's Homes located in the hills of Kalimpong, India, is more than just another virtual choir.

This short music film was put together not just to showcase the talent of our school but to give the world a small glimpse of the vision and incredible impact of our school on the lives of so many people across the world. This project brought together 31 alumni of Dr Grahams ranging from the ICSE Batch of 1962 all the way to 2016!!

### **The Vision & Origin of the project**

Music has always been at the heart of DGH, especially choral music and as I began to watch various virtual choir productions during the Covid 19 lockdown, I began to envision a music production with the Dr Graham's Homes OGBs (Old Girls & Boys). What started off as a personal dream slowly became a reality!

### **The Process and Challenges**

Through my organization, Inspire, I was able to get our team to start work. The coordination for this project turned out to be quite tough and took much longer than I anticipated. It has been 3 months of hard work, vision casting and discussions, contacting the alumni, collecting audio and video files that were sent from more than 15 different locations across the globe, overcoming challenges like asking for audio & video files to be redone because of poor quality or video files that did not sync with the audio files and even connectivity issues while one of our singers was sailing on a ship!! And that was just the beginning!! Then began the process of arranging the music and vocals, editing, re editing, mixing and submitting multiple drafts before everyone was happy. The limitations of virtual music productions are huge especially since more than 80% of the participants were recording files like this for the first time and were mostly using simple android phones! It has been challenging yet hugely fulfilling!

Despite all the limitations we are proud of the final production not just because we believe it is beautiful musically, but because through this we have also achieved so much more, like reconnecting old friends, reliving memories and emotions, sharing our love for our school with others and even motivating and encouraging people to contribute and make a difference!



**The Larger Vision behind the production**

While the song has come together beautifully, we also wanted to use this opportunity for a larger purpose and a bigger vision. We decided to not just make a music video but to use this as an opportunity to give back and make a difference. This is why we chose the song “Heal the World” which is particularly relevant in the broken and unsafe world we are living in, especially for children! In different parts of the song we have used footage of the Homes showing why we believe it is a beautiful place giving children a chance for a happy childhood.

Towards the end of the song we encourage those watching, especially OGBs, to give more children this opportunity. It is a call to sponsor a child and talks about helping children who otherwise may not have had the opportunity to grow up safe and healthy
