### PHASE 1 and PHASE 2 OF THE CLASSROOM REFURBISHMENT PROJECT

This information is provided, to give everyone a holistic idea of the contribution made by everyone, to the success of the “Adopt a Classroom” Project. This Project, started with a hope and faith that OGBs, worldwide, would hear the appeal and “rise up” to the call.

The appeal for donations and support went out to OGBs and Friends in June 2021. By August 2021, the GO Managing Committee, was happy to commence the “Adopt a Classroom” project.

Below are some fun facts of the Classroom Projects.

#### 1. QUEEN MARY BLOCK – Junior School

- This Project took 3 months during the months of September & October 2021 and January 2022
- To take advantage of the labour and material available to the Project Team, number of Classrooms were being refurbished simultaneously
- The First ‘model’ template Class was handed over to the DGH Administration on 24 September 2021
- Total cost of 12 Classroom refurbishment = Rs.25,22,325

#### 2. HORNELL BLOCK – Middle School

- The Hornell Block involved 4 large and 6 medium size Classrooms.
- The floors were in better condition and did not involve as extensive floor repair work as some of the Junior School Classroom floors required.
- Phase 2 commenced on 3 May 2022 through to early July 2022.
- Total cost of 10 Classroom refurbishment = Rs.24,94,954
